Academic Requirements:

- Successful completion of an Undergraduate degree from a recognised higher education institution, with a **GPA** of at least **2.0 out of 4.0**. Some background or experience in a relevant discipline (including Engineering, Technology, or Science) would be an advantage.
 - Applicants who have successfully completed a relevant degree with a **GPA** of at least **1.5 out of 4**, will be considered if they have **at least 5** years of relevant industry experience. *It is a requirement that the bachelor's degree was completed with no more than 25 per cent of subjects failed.*
- or
- Successful completion of an **Australian postgraduate qualification** (or international equivalent) in a related discipline.
- or
- Submitted other evidence of **general and professional qualifications** that demonstrates potential to pursue graduate studies.

English Language Requirements:

Applicants must:

- Demonstrate that they have a satisfactory command of the English language. Where English is not the first language or where an applicant has completed studies in a language other than English, it is necessary to demonstrate proficiency in English by achieving a prescribed level in an approved English examination meeting the standards listed below. The approved English Language tests include the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) (academic), Pearson Test of English, and the Cambridge Certificate of Advanced English.
- Valid minimum scores include:
 - **IELTS Academic** with an **overall score of 6.5+** (with **only one band** score allowed to be **6.0**), or
 - **PTE** with an **overall score of 58+** (with **only one skill** allowed to be **50-57**), or
 - **Cambridge Certificate of Advanced English (CAE) 176 with no component less than 169.**
- If any IELTS (academic) band is below 6 or comparative band scores in equivalent tests or the IELTS (academic) test was not undertaken by the applicant within the last 12 months, the applicant will need to **attend an interview** with the relevant Program Coordinator (or delegate, being a senior academic) to confirm that the applicant has sufficient English proficiency to undertake the course and to inform the applicant that they will be required to take an **English Language Assessment** during orientation and take the **English Support program** for reading and writing if enrolled.
